1. Admirals Arch

Located in Flinders Chase National Park, this stunning natural rock arch can be reached by a boardwalk, with the added bonus of a colony of NZ fur seals in residence. Open 7 days, Visitor Centre open 9am – 5pm every day except Christmas Day. Please note – all parks closed on days of Catastrophic Fire Danger.

2. Remarkable Rocks

Also in Flinders Chase National Park, these rocks truly are remarkable. Sculpted by the elements over 500 million years, be dwarfed by the formations as you walk around them. Open 7 days, Visitor Centre open 9am – 5pm every day except Christmas Day. Please note – all parks closed on days of Catastrophic Fire Danger.

3. Vivonne Bay

Voted one of Australia's top beaches, Vivonne Bay has a beautiful, long, sandy beach ideal for picnics and swimming and is also great for fishing. Open access.

4. Stokes Bay

Follow the signs from the car park, through a tunnel and path to find a beautiful white sand beach, ideal for relaxing. Open access.

5. Duck Lagoon

Near Cygnet River, Duck Lagoon offers a serene area to enjoy beautiful red gums, great bird life and picnic area. Open access.

6. Little Sahara

Stumble across a surprising series of huge sand dunes, where you can sandboard or just marvel! Sandboard hire from KI Outdoor Action. Open 7 days, 9am – 5pm.

Limestone cave system - guided tours. Walking trails in the park. Open 7 days, Visitor Centre open 10.15 am – 4.30pm daily. Closed Christmas Day.

10. Western River Cove

An isolated and sheltered beach with beautiful white sand. Walk over the footbridge along the riverbank to a hidden sandy cove. Open access.

11. Emu Bay

A beautiful 4km beach with vehicle access to the hard sand. Safe, clear water for swimming. Open access.

12. Pennington Bay

Stunning beach offering beautiful views of the Island meeting the Southern Ocean. A photographer's delight. Open access.

13. Island Beach

Beautiful sandy beach, safe for swimming. Known locally as "Millionaires Row" for its fabulous real estate. Open access.

14. American River

Quiet, friendly fishing village, great for sailing, birdwatching and fishing. Open access.

15. Murray Lagoon

The Island's largest lagoon, supporting abundant birdlife and offering walking opportunities. Open access. Please note – all parks closed on days of Catastrophic Fire Danger.
